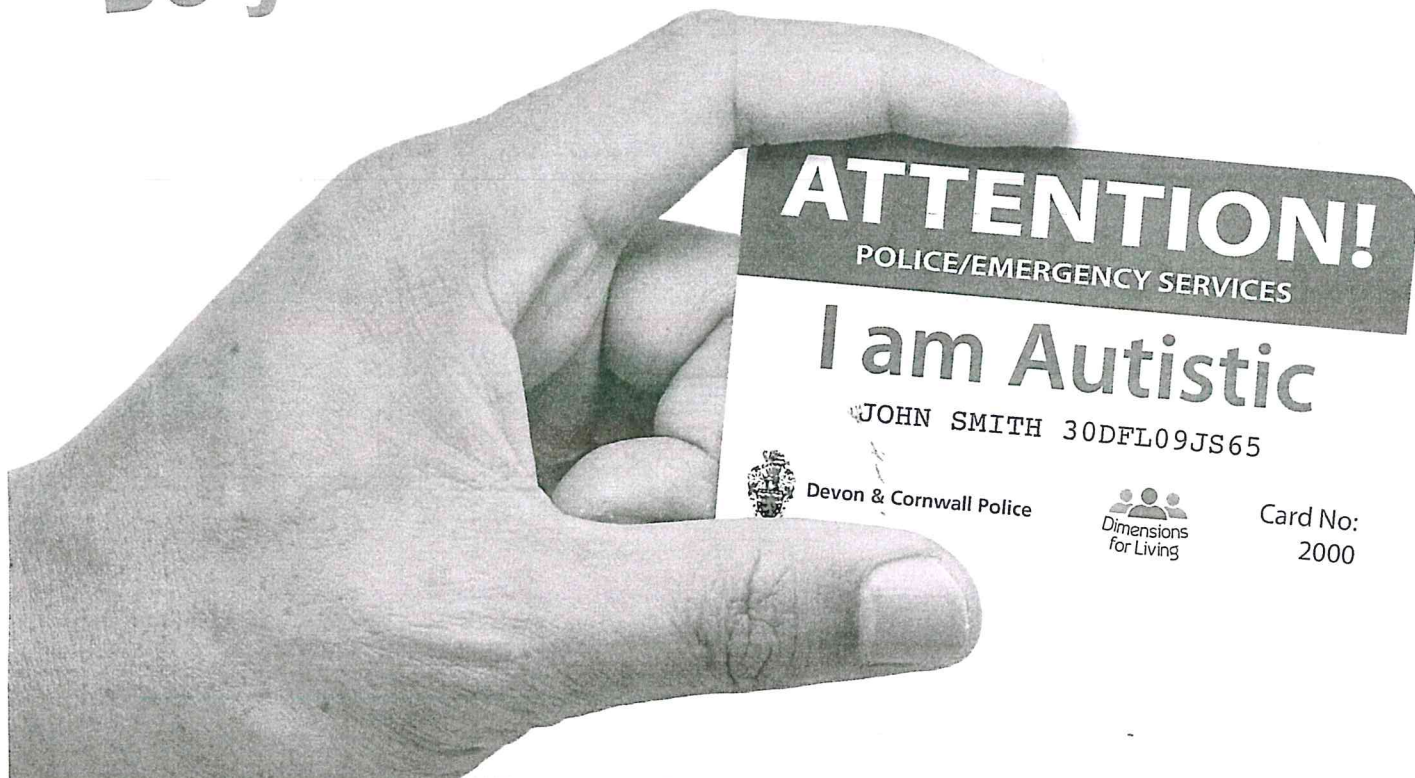

The South Devon Special Care Dental Service would like to raise awareness of mouth cancer and encourage more people to get checked regularly. These sessions have been set up to raise awareness along with provision of advice and free mouth cancer screenings.

Please note: the screening is for mouth cancer and **does not** replace a normal dental check-up in a dental clinic. Screenings may vary but would typically consist of an examination of the tongue, gums, lips, inside cheeks, and the roof and floor of the mouth.

People may 'drop in' on the day at the above location for a free Mouth Cancer check. If we advise you to contact an NHS dentist for further treatment NHS charges would apply, unless you are exempt.
