We will be reading 'The Ocean Gardener' which is a lovely story which focuses on protecting our oceans. In maths we will be focusing on 'number' and in PSHE pupils will be working on 'building relationships.'

We also have a big focus on communication. We use Makaton signing and communication boards to model and support and teach pupils to communicate effectively.

Teachers have been busy baselining pupil's knowledge to ensure that lessons are planned to build on prior skills to ensure good progression. Teaching will be adapted in ways to suit individual's needs.
