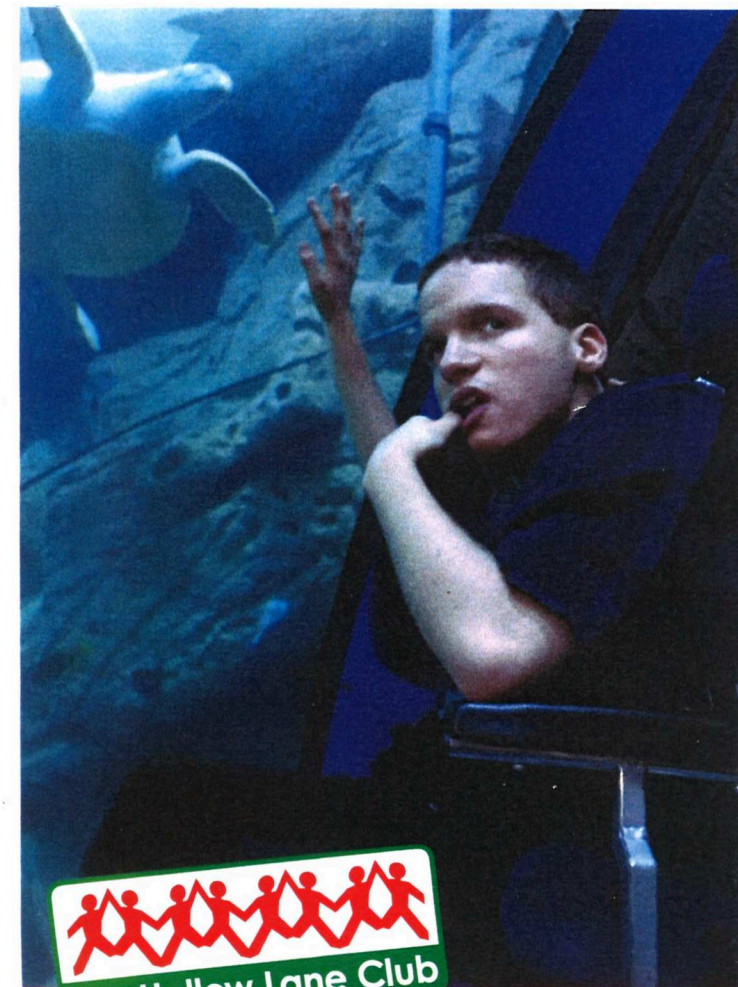


## The future...

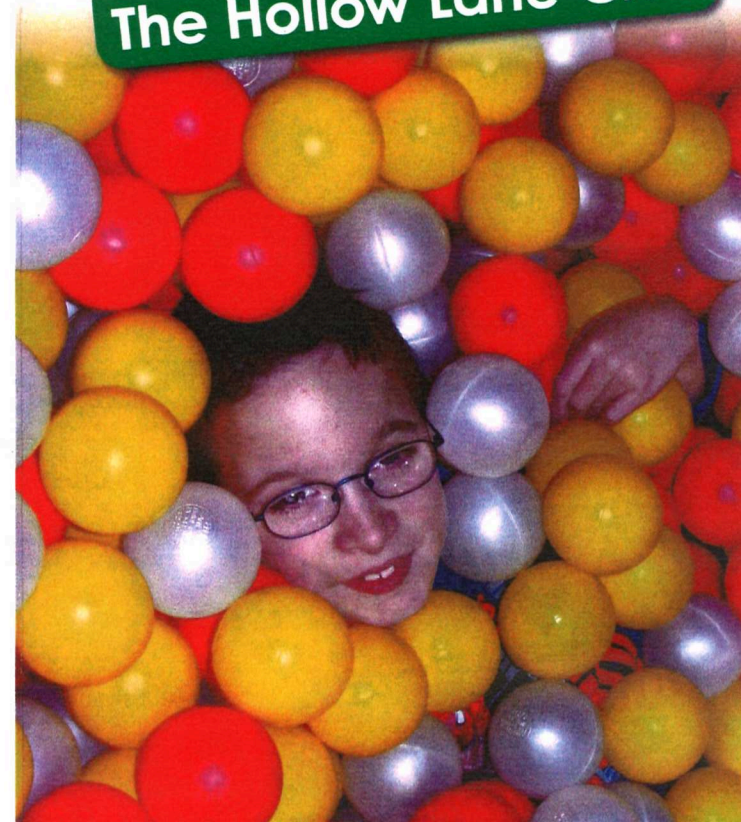

The Clubs are open to young people from the ages of 3-19 years.

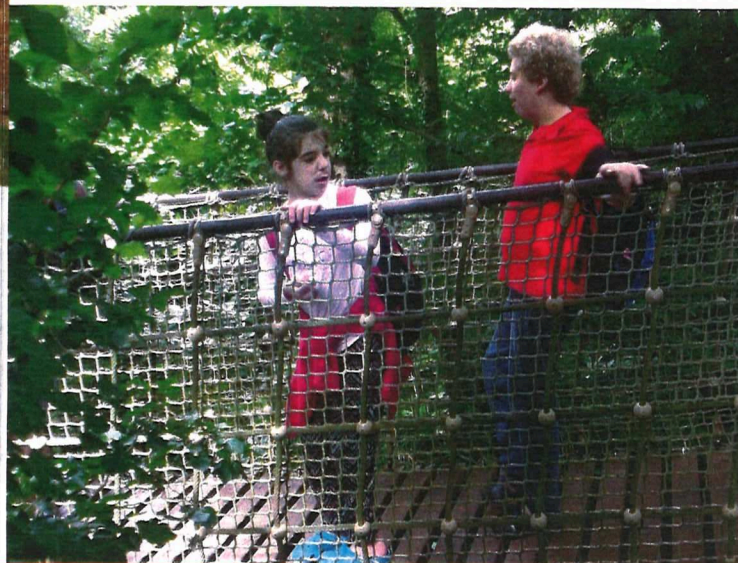
As demand is high, we operate a waiting list system.

## What are the costs?

We strive to keep costs to a minimum in order that the Clubs are accessible to all.

The charge to families is a heavily subsidised rate which is supported by charitable fund raising. Places can be paid for by direct payments or Social Care can purchase places.
