FINANCIAL SUPPORT

The school is able to access financial support for any families who are struggling. If you are finding it very difficult to make ends meet, especially with the holidays coming up, please contact Daisy Binnie or your Class Teacher.

The only criteria we have to meet is that we haven't applied for this money for you in the last year and you are in need. We can apply for Food Vouchers to get boxes from local Food Banks anytime you need them.

We will keep your request totally confidential.

The funds can be requested to cover:

- Providing vouchers for food;
- Supporting with energy and water bills for household purposes;
- Emergency boiler and heating repairs;
- Essential white goods such as a fridge, freezer or cooker.

The scheme can also help with petrol costs to keep you in work and with your broadband.

All families with children on Free School Meals will have received a voucher for the holidays. Please call the School Office if you haven't had yours.

HOLIDAY ACTIVITIES AND FOOD CHRISTMAS HOLIDAY PROGRAMME (HAF)

The Holiday Activities and Food Christmas Holiday Programme is primarily for children aged 5-16 years (and can include 4-year-olds already in Reception year) who are either eligible for and receiving benefits-related free school meals (FSM) or are classed as vulnerable:

Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) programme - Education and Families (devon.gov.uk)

School holidays can be particularly difficult for some families because of increased costs (such as food) and reduced incomes. For some children that can lead to a holiday experience gap, with children from disadvantaged families less likely to access organised out-of-school activities, more likely to experience 'unhealthy holidays' in terms of nutrition and physical health and more likely to experience social isolation.
